WALKS

Zumwalt Meadow Meander

Explore the variety of environments around this classic location of Kings Canyon on a leisurely walk with a ranger. Please bring a hat, drinking water, good shoes, and sunscreen. Meet at the Zumwalt Meadow parking area. (1 ½ hours, up to 1 ½ miles, topics vary.)

Join Ranger Phyllis Wilson in character as early Kings Canyon pioneer Viola Kanawyer. Explore the historic site of Camp Kanawyer and discover how to live in 19th century Kings Canyon. Meet at the Roads End Permit Station.

Take a tour of the planets, meet the constellations, and celebrate the darkness at Kings Canyon National Park! Join Park Ranger Tim Lutterman to discover the magic of the night sky through storytelling and a guided tour of the spring stars. Meet at the Cedar Grove Amphitheater (one hour).
