### Program Descriptions

**Sherman Tree Talk:** 20 minutes. Meet at the base of the General Sherman Tree. Learn about the largest tree on the planet and its secrets for survival. 

**Snowshoe Walk:** 2 hours. 1 mile. Join a ranger for a snowshoe walk through the winter woods on old fashioned wooden snowshoes provided. No snowshoe experience necessary. All participants should wear waterproof footwear and dress warmly. Not recommended for children under the age of 10. Reservations required; limit 18 participants.
