Program Descriptions

Critter Talk

30 minutes. Meet at the Lodgepole Visitor Center. Discover more about the animals that call Sequoia National Park home.

Full Moon on Moro Rock

1 hour. Meet a Sequoia Natural History Association Naturalist at the top of Moro Rock. Listen to some stories as the moon rises.

Realm of Giants Walk

2 hours; 1 mile. Meet at Giant Forest Museum. Deepen your understanding and appreciation of the world's largest trees.

Pumpkin Carving

2 hours. Meet a Sequoia Natural History Association Naturalist downstairs in Wuksachi. Listen to stories while making your own jack-o-lantern. Stop by any time between 6:00 and 8:00.

Scat & Tracks Talk

30 minutes. Meet at the Lodgepole Visitor Center. Investigate the clues just like a crime scene investigator would and discover what animals you may find in the forest.

Sherman Tree Talk

20 minutes. Meet at the base of the General Sherman Tree. Learn about the largest tree on the planet and its secrets for survival.

Tokopah Walk

2 hours; 3.5 miles. Meet at the old Walter Fry Nature Center bathroom in Lodgepole Campground. Explore how water has shaped and is still changing the Sierra Nevada.

Wonders of the Night Sky

1 hour; ½ mile. Meet in Wuksachi Lobby. Join a Sequoia Natural History Association naturalist to explore the beauty and wonder of the parks' protected sky. Bring warm layers and a flashlight.
