- Ranger in the Grove** How big? How old? What happens in a fire? Look for a ranger along the Grant Tree Trail to have all your giant sequoia questions answered.
- Big Tree Talk** Meet a ranger at the base of the General Grant Tree to learn what it takes to be one of the largest trees on Earth. 15 minutes.
- Campfire Talk** Join a ranger at the Sunset Amphitheater for a 1-hour talk or slide show about the people, places and things that make Kings Canyon National Park so special.
