Program Descriptions:

California Grizzlies: The grizzly bear disappeared from California in 1922, when the last one was shot right here in Tulare County. Meet Ranger Frank Helling in the Discovery Room at the Kings Canyon Visitor Center to learn more about the history of this magnificent bear. *30 minutes.* ♿

Evening Program: Meet in the Lobby of the John Muir Lodge for a talk or slide show about the people, places and things that make Kings Canyon National Park so special. *45 minutes.* ♿

***Snowshoe Walk: No experience necessary! We provide the snowshoes; you bring warm layered clothing, waterproof boots, gloves, hat, sunglasses, sunscreen, water and a snack. This activity is moderately strenuous and recommended for ages 9 and up. Reservations required; limit 15 participants.
