Trip Name: Hazel Country Semi-Circuit (15-20 Mile Circuit)

Trip Description: Explore the wilderness while riding past former homesites and farms.

Trail Stability: Not a suitable route for wet/winter conditions.

PATC Map: PATC #10 (Central District)

Encounters: Route uses county roads outside of the park (No busy highways are included). Weekends bring

heavy hiking and/or backpacking along this route.

Footing: Long stretches are rough, rocky, narrow, and/or in wilderness. Potential for troublesome stream

crossings. You and your horse should be in excellent condition.

Skyline Drive Parking: Meadow Springs Parking. Goose-neck trailer OK. Trailer parking may be limited.

Boundary Parking: N/A

Total Distance 15.5 Miles

Park at Meadow Spring Parking, mile 33.5.

Ride down Hazel Mountain Trail for 4.1 miles.

Bear left, now on Pine Hill Gap Trail and ride another 2.1 miles.

Turn left onto state route 681, riding 1.8 miles.

Turn left onto state route 600, riding 1.2 miles.

Turn left onto private road, staying on south side of river, for about 0.3 mile.

Turn right onto Hazel River Trail and ride 3.4 miles.

Turn right, back onto Hazel Mountain Trail, and ride 2.9 miles to return to your vehicle.
