NOTE.—This company was organized at Jefferson, Texas, September 15, 1861, and reported for service in the Confederate States Army at Bowling Green, Kentucky. By special order No. 247, Headquarters, Western Department, Confederate States Army, December 1, 1861, it was attached to the regiment being organized by Colonel Thomas H. Hunt, then known as the 5th Regiment and subsequently as the 9th Regiment Infantry, Kentucky Volunteers. At the reorganization of the Confederate Army of the Western Department at Corinth, Mississippi, this company was on April 25, 1862, consolidated with and became a part of Captain Christian Bosche's Company "H." Most of the Texans were subsequently retransferred, May, 1863, to Texas organizations.

HISTORY OF NINTH REGIMENT INFANTRY, KENTUCKY

The following account of the action of the Confederate Congress has reference to the change of the 5th Kentucky Regiment to be the 9th Regiment Kentucky Infantry:

A joint resolution to correct the records of the War Department concerning the 9th Kentucky Regiment of Infantry:

Whereas the excellent regiment of infantry organized at Bowling Green, Ky., in September, 1861, by its Colonel Thomas H. Hunt, served with distinction at Shiloh, at Vicksburg, during the siege of 1862, and at Baton Rouge, as the 5th Kentucky Regiment of Volunteers, and is so mentioned in the records of the War Department, and

Whereas the War Department has since decided that another regiment is properly the 5th, and the regiment so organized and commanded by Col. Hunt the 9th; therefore, be it

Resolved, by the Congress of the Confederate States, that the Secretary of War is hereby instructed to alter all records in his department wherein the 9th Kentucky Regiment of Infantry is mentioned as the 5th Regiment, that due credit may be given, and justice done, to that gallant and skillful officer, Col. Hunt, and the brave and heroic officers and men of said regiment.

(H. R., by H. W. Bruce. Read 1st and 2d time; reported back; engrossed; read three times and passed.)

The preliminary organization of the Fifth, afterwards the

Ninth Regiment Infantry, Kentucky Volunteers, Confederate States Army, took place at Camp Boone, Tennessee, and completed after assembling with the forces gathered at Bowling Green, Ky., under Generals Albert Sidney Johnston and Simon Bolivar Buckner. The regiment was organized from recruits as they could escape through the Federal lines, and not under any State auspices.

The companies were recruited during September and October, 1861.

The notes supplied by the regimental rolls furnish in part, a concise history of the operations of the regiment as one of the First Kentucky (Orphan) Brigade.

Roll of Dec. 31, 1861, Oakland—On the 5th of October the regiment went into Camp at Camp Warren, near Bowling Green; moved thence by railroad to Russellville, on November 2; thence by way of Dripping Springs and Merry Oaks to Oakland Station. On the night of the 5th a guard from this regiment stationed at Whippoorwill Bridge, on the M. C. & L. R. R., had a battle with the Federals.

Roll of April 30, 1862, near Corinth, Miss.—Left Camp Clear Water, February 12, 1862, by way of Nashville, Murfreesboro, Huntsville, Decatur, Burnsville; thence to Shiloh, where we participated in the battle of April 6th and 7th, and marched to Corinth.

Roll of December 2, 1862, Murfreesboro, Tenn.—Left Jackson, September 11th, by railroad to Holly Springs; thence to Knoxville; thence by railroad to Shell Mound; left Shell Mound, October 25th, for Murfreesboro.

Roll of February 1, 1863, Manchester, Tennessee.—Left camp at Murfreesboro, Dec. 28, 1862, for Stone River; engaged in various skirmishes and returned to Manchester.

Roll of February 28, 1863, Manchester, Tennessee.—The regiment remained in line of battle subjected to enemy's cannonade until January 4th, 1863, when its position before Murfreesboro was evacuated, arriving at Manchester, January 6th.

Roll of April 30, 1863, Beech Grove, Tennessee.—Remained in camp at Manchester until April 21, 1863; night of the 21st marched to Morrison's Bridge to repel a raid of the enemy; returned on the 22d. On the 23d we marched to Beech Grove.

Roll of June 30, 1863, Jackson, Miss.—Marched to Hoover's Gap; to Wartrace on May 24th; thence by railroad to Jackson, Miss.; participated in siege of Jackson from 10th to 16th, when we evacuated and reached Brandon on the 17th; thence to Camp Hurricane where we arrived on the 28th.

Roll of October 31, 1863, Tyner's Station.—Left Morton, Mississippi, Aug. 27, by railroad for Tyner's Station; marched to Chattanooga; thence in retreat to Lafayette, Ga.; thence to Chickamauga; engaged in battle at that place, Sept. 19th and 20th, 1863; thence to Missionary Ridge; thence to this station.

Roll of Dec. 31, 1863, Dalton, Ga.—Left Tyner's Station, Nov. 23d for Missionary Ridge; engaged in battle at that place on November 25th, and marched to Dalton.

Roll of August 3d, 1864, Jonesboro, Georgia.—Left Dalton, May 7th; engaged in skirmish at Rocky Face Ridge on 8th to 12th of May. Engaged in battle at Resaca, on 13th to 15th. Engaged in skirmishes at Dallas. Engaged in battle of Peach Tree Creek, July 20th. July 22d attacked the enemy on his left and rear, and engaged in skirmishes at Atlanta and Jonesboro.

Roll of October 31, 1864, Stockbridge, Georgia.—Engaged in battle of Jonesboro, September 1, 1864, and by various marches arrived at this place October 27th, 1864.

From Stockbridge, Georgia, the regiment went to Barnesville, Georgia, and was there mounted. Proceeding in the wake of General Sherman's army in its "March to the Sea," and crossing into South Carolina, was engaged in mounted service, and returning into Georgia, was surrendered at Washington, Georgia, May 6, 1865.
