SECOND REGIMENT, KENTUCKY

This Regiment was organized at Camp Boone, Tennessee, on July 17, 1861, and was sent under command of Col. Roger Hanson to Fort Donelson, where most of the Regiment was captured with the surrender of the fort on February 16, 1862. The Regiment carried into action about 600 men, and lost nearly 80

men killed and wounded. It was subsequently exchanged and participated in the severe engagements at Hartsville, Tenn., and also Murfreesboro, Chickamauga, Missionary Ridge, Rock-face Gap and Jackson, Miss. Took conspicuous part in the hundred days' battle from Dalton to Atlanta, Ga., which included
