

## Descendants of Abraham B. Boyd

### Generation No. 1

1. ABRAHAM B.<sup>2</sup> BOYD (*UNKNOWN*)<sup>1,1,2,3</sup> was born 07 Apr 1818 in Wilson County, Tennessee<sup>4</sup>, and died 28 Dec 1904 in Limestone County, Alabama. He married (1) NANCY ROUTON 06 Jan 1842 in Wilson County, Tennessee, daughter of RICHARD ROUTON and MARY RANKIN. She was born Abt. 1815, and died Abt. 1855 in Tennessee. He married (2) RACHEL MCCLURE 16 Apr 1856 in Wilson County, Tennessee. She was born 1815 in North Carolina, and died in Tennessee. He married (3) DEBORAH EMILINE MUSE 02 Feb 1896 in Limestone County, Alabama. She was born 29 Dec 1855, and died 26 Apr 1930.

#### Notes for ABRAHAM B. BOYD:

On March 3, 1871 Abraham B. Boyd filed a claim with the Southern Claims Commission in Warren County, Tennessee to get compensation for property taken by United States military personnel for use in the Civil War. The claim was barred.

Abraham Boyd applied for a Confederate Pension in Athens, Limestone County, Alabama on 5 June, 1899. In this application he states that he enlisted in the Service of the State of Tennessee, or Confederate States, as a private in company K, in the 44 Tennessee Regiment in Dec of 1861 at Hillsboro, Coffee County, Tennessee and that he was honorably discharged in Dec 1862 at Poplar Grove, Tennessee due to his age. He states that he is 81 years of age, making his year of birth 1818 and not 1825 as his tombstone reads, and that his post office address is Tickridge, Limestone County, Alabama. This application is witnessed by Henry Jackson Boyd.

2. HENRY JACKSON<sup>3</sup> BOYD (*ABRAHAM B.<sup>2</sup>, UNKNOWN*)<sup>7,8,9,10</sup> was born 12 Mar 1842 in Tennessee, and died 28 Feb 1918 in Limestone County, Alabama. He married (1) SARAH ELIZABETH DAVIS 23 Jul 1865 in Coffee County, Tennessee, daughter of JONATHAN DAVIS and PERNETIA WILLIAMS. She was born 1846 in Tennessee, and died Abt. 1874 in Warren County, Tennessee. He married (2) MARTHA MONKS 04 Nov 1874 in Lincoln County, Tennessee, daughter of THOMAS MONKS and ELIZABETH BOSTICK. She was born 28 May 1849 in Lincoln County, Tennessee, and died 21 Jul 1928 in Limestone County, Alabama.

#### Notes for HENRY JACKSON BOYD:

Henry J.E. Boyd enlisted as a Pvt., Co. C, 44 Reg Tennessee Infantry, C.S.A. on Dec. 9, 1861 at Camp Trousdale, Tennessee. Appears on a list of killed, wounded and missing, in Cleburne's Division, Hardee's Corps, A.T., in the battle of Murfreesboro, Tenn., Dec. 31, 1862. Wounded in eye. Promoted to Corporal Co. K, 44 (Consolidated) Tennessee Infantry. Captured at Chickamauga, Ga. Sept. 19, 1863. Forwarded as a prisoner of war to Louisville, Ky Oct. 1, 1863 for exchange. Sent to Camp Douglas, Chicago, Illinois, received during Oct., 1863. Transferred March 23, 1865 to Point Lookout, Md. Released at Point Lookout, Md., June 9, 1865, on taking the Oath of Allegiance to the United States. Returned to Coffee, Co., Tennessee to marry Mary Elizabeth Davis on July 23,

1865.

Notes for MARTHA MONKS:

On 13 Oct 1922 Martha Ann Boyd, RFD#5 Athens, Alabama filed a "Widows Blank for Reclassification Under Section 11, As Amended By Acts of Legislature Approved October 5th 1920". In this application she states that she is living with her son David M. Boyd and that she was born 28 May 1849 in Lincoln County, Tennessee and that her father was Thomas Washington Monks who died in Lincoln County, Tennessee in 1895. She further states that she married her husband Henry Jackson Boyd, who died in 1918, in 1874 in Lincoln County, Tennessee. He enlisted on the service of the Confederate States in Coffee County, Tennessee and was on the pension roll of Limestone County, Alabama.

He married (1) VANDALIA TUCKER WINSETT 14 Nov 1886 in Limestone County, Alabama. She was born 22 Jun 1858, and died 29 Sep 1888 in Limestone County, Alabama. He married (2) SARAH ANN SALLIE SHELTON 24 Jan 1889 in Limestone County, Alabama, daughter of WILLIAM SHELTON and NANCY MORRIS. She was born 01 May 1866 in Madison County, Alabama, and died 28 Oct 1914 in Limestone County, Alabama.
