

Appointed by Col. C. B. Seidel, in camp at Buck Head, Georgia, before the Confederate works, as Acting Chief Bugler, which position he held during the remainder of the Atlantic Campaign, including the Kilpatrick Raid, and through the Great Wilson Raid to the close of the war. Mustered out August, 1865, at Edgfield, Tennessee. Age 17 years.
