Jessie C Clements Letter to his Commander

Camp 32nd Ala Regt. Jackson. June 19, 1863

Lieut Col. H. Maury, Commanding

Sir, In the Mississippian of this date, I find Special Order No. 107 of General Johnston, Commanding Department of the West, offering amnesty to all deserters, for past offenses, "provided they come in without difficulty."

I have the honor to represent to you that there are about fifteen men of Company A now absent without leave, the names of some of which have been dropped from the rolls of the Company. These men mostly were residents of Washington County, Alabama. I feel well satisfied that if permitted to go after them and others of the Regiment absent under like circumstances in Clarke and adjoining counties, clothed with the authority contained in said Order, I could speedily gather a large number of them and return them to the Regiment perhaps in time for the anticipated active movements of this army.

Jesse Clements Form No. 318

I, the undersigned, Prisoner of War, belonging to the Army of the Department of Alabama, Mississippi, and East Louisiana, having been surrendered by Lieut. Gen. R, Taylor, C.S.A., Commanding said Department, to Major General E.R.L. Canby, U.S.A., Commanding Army and Division of West Mississippi, do hereby give my solemn parole of honor that I will not hereafter serve in the Armies of the Confederate States, or in any military capacity whatever, against the United States of America, or under aid to the enemies of the latter, until properly exchanged in such manner as shall be mutually approved by the respective authorities.

Done at Meridian, Miss.

this 10th day of May, 1865

The above named officer will not be disturbed by United States authorities, as long as he observes his parole, and the laws in force where he resides.
