The third of Marietta's lost valedictorians was **Timothy L. Condit** 1860. After working his way through school as a printer, he enlisted in the **First Ohio Cavalry** in the spring of 1862 and earned a commission as a second lieutenant. Serving in Tennessee later that same year, his company was encircled while defending a wagon train on the battlefield at Murfreesboro. Condit sought to lead his men to safety by charging the Confederate attackers but was killed, Dec. 31, 1862.
