Ganger who was ENROLLED on the 16th day of

October, 1862, in Company K of the 57th regiment of Ind Inf Vols

commanded by Capt Edwin L Billings for 9 months and was honorably DISCHARGED at

Hillsborough Tenn. on the 30th day of July, 1863; That his

personal description is as follows: Age 18 years; height 5 feet 10 1/4 inches; complexion Fair

hair Light; eyes Blue That while a member of the organization aforesaid, in the

service and in the line of duty at Stone River in the State of Tennessee.

on or about the 31st day of December, 1862, he incurred a severe

of wound or injury. If disabled by disease, state fully its cause, if by wound or injury, the precise manner in which received.

which brought on rheumatism which became

chronic and has continued ever since.

During the fight at Stone River he became heated

and over worked. It rained the last day of the

fight as he remembers it and his comrades had to

lie that night only in their blankets, and when

they were awakened in the morning the water

was running all around them. From this time

on applicant was troubled with pain in his limbs

and upon any slight exposure or change of the

weather he would suffer ^{and} during his entire

service ^{thereafter} and since up to the present time.

That he was not treated in any hospital He used to get medicine of Regimental

Doctor for it. He was unfit for duty and they

were going to send him by boat to Atlanta. But at his earnest

request they let him stay with the Regt. and put his gun on the wagon.

That he has been employed in the military or naval service otherwise than as stated above after the above term

service he resigned as a veteran - was enrolled in Co. D, 22nd Regt

Ind Inf Vols and Inf. Jan 4th 1864 Discharged July 24th 1864

That he has not been in the military or naval service of the United States since the 24th day of July, 1864

That since leaving the service this applicant has resided in Elkhart County

in the state of Indiana, and that his occupation has been that of a Farmer and Miller

That prior to his entry into the service above named he was a man of good, sound, physical health, being when enrolled a

Farmer Laborer That he is now one half disabled

from obtaining his subsistence by manual labor by reason of his injuries, above described, received in the service of

the United States; and he therefore makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the invalid

pension roll of the United States. He hereby appoints with full power of substitution and revocation.

Daniel Ganger, claimant herein, being first duly sworn, on his oath deposes and says: that he first enlisted on the 16th day of October, 1862 in Co. K, 57th Regiment, Indiana Volunteer Infantry, and was discharged therefrom at Hillsboro, Tennessee, on the 30th day of July, 1863. That he then returned to his home at Goshen, Indiana, where he, on January 4th, 1864, re-enlisted as a private in the Co. E, 74th Indiana Volunteer Infantry, from which company and regiment he was transferred on June 9th, 1865 to Co. I, 22nd Ind. Vol. Infantry. That he was mustered out of the service of the United States as a private in said Co. I, 22nd Ind. Vol. Inf. on the 24th day of July, 1865 at Louisville, Kentucky.




