Hello Ranger Lewis:


My husband and I visited the battlefield end of April and discussed with you the possibility of my sending you a photograph of my Great Grandfather, Beert Vander Hoop. (We knew him as Burt). Enclosed is the photo.

His unit was the Michigan 13th Volunteers, Infantry, Company I and was there during the Battle of Stone's River and the Battle at Chickamauga.

He was born in Oldebrook, Gelderland, Netherlands in 1838 and arrived in the U.S. in (I believe) 1857. He bought a farm in 1865 near Drenthe, Michigan, and joined the Michigan Volunteers in 1861, was mustered out in 1864, and later lived in Overeissel, Michigan, until his death in 1930 at age 92.

Hope this is the information you need for your files. We were very impressed by the visitor's center and surrounding battlefield.
