R W Carpenter's Company, Martins [sic] Regiment of Texas Dis Cavalry, who was enlisted on tenth Day of July one thousand eight hundred and sixty-Two to serve the war is hereby Honorably Discharged from the Army of the Confederate States, HAVING REMAINED TRUE TO HIS COLORS TO THE LAST.

Said C.J. Tinnin was born in Stodard [sic] County in the State of Missouri, is 29 years of age, 6 feet, [line drawn through] inches high, Fair complexion, blue eyes, dark hair; and by occupation when enlisted a Farmer
