To all whom it may Concern.

Know ye, That Franklin Walker a Private of Captain James A Rice Company, (K",) 73rd Regiment of Ills Vol Inf. VOLUNTEERS, who was enrolled on the First day of August one thousand eight hundred and Sixty-two to serve Three years or [illegible] the war, is hereby Discharged from the service of the United States this 23rd day of May, 1865, at Murfreesboro Tenn [sic] by reason of being mustered out in accordance with [illegible] in telegram per War Dept dated May 3d 1863

(No objection to his being re-enlisted is known to exist.)

Said Franklin Walker was born in Summer County in the State of Pennsylvania, is 35 years of age, 5 feet 9 inches high, Dark complexion, Black eyes, Black hair, and by occupation, when enrolled, a Carpenter

Given at Murfreesboro Tenn [sic] this 23d day of May 1865
