Letter from Riggs Whitcomb to S. B. Whitcomb from Franklin, TN February 22, 1864

feb [sic] 22 1864

Franklin Tennessee

Dear Cousin it has been a long time since that I have heard from you I will write a few lines to let you know that I am well and I hope that this will find you the same Orin is sick and I am taking care of him he was takeing [sic] bleeding to the lungs he had two speels [sic] at it he is a little better now I have been here four weeks he has reenlisted and is going home when he gets able I enlisted the 4 of January we are boarding at a private house he fares as well as he would at home write soon as you get this and let me know all about the folks there no more at this time
