Letter regarding Jon Withers' Death June 1862
Murfreesboro June 19 1862

Mr [sic] Lampson Withers

Dear Sir

I have to inform you that your son John Withers died in Gen. Hospital at this place on Sunday the 11th inst. with brane [sic] fever. he was not in his wright [sic] mind and knew no one for 2days before he died I have sent his mony [sic] and personal effects all to his Wife who I suppose is at Muscootink, Min.

Your son was a noble harted [sic] man one whome [sic] I shall ever remember with respect.

Pension Application Receipt Form

I have the honor to acknowledge the receipt from your Office of application for Pension No. 56716 and to return it herewith, with such information as is furnished by the files of this Office.

It appears from the Rolls on file in this Office, that John Withers was enrolled on the 30 day of Oct, 1861, at Ft Snelling in Co. "K" 3rd Regiment of Minnesota Volunteers, to serve 3 years, or during the war, and mustered into service as a Private on the 14 day of Nov, 1861, at Ft Snelling, in Co. "K", 3rd Regiment of Minnesota Volunteers, to serve 3 years or during the war. On the Muster Roll of Co. "K" of that Regiment, for the months of May and June 1862, he is reported "Died in Genl [sic] Hospital at Murfreesboro June 15th 1862" Cause of death not stated.
