Donelson, Tenn., February 16, 1862, released at Vicksburg, Miss., September 23, 1862; re-organized September 26, 1862, and declared exchanged at Aiken's Landing Nov. 10, 1862. It was temporarily consolidated with the 26th Regiment Tennessee Infantry on October 8, 1863, but each company of the two organizations

was mustered separately and under its original designation during the period covered by this consolidation.

About April 9, 1865, the 2d, 3d, 10th, 15th, 18th, 20th, 26th, 30th, 32d, 37th, and 45th Regiments and the 23d Battalion Tennessee Infantry were consolidated and formed the 4th Consolidated Regiment Tennessee Infantry, which was paroled at Greensboro, N. C. May 1, 1865.
