Reinvesting in Urban Parks

Bartlett Park, a 30-acre urban parkland, is located in an economically disadvantaged urban neighborhood within St. Petersburg's Midtown area. Through the Midtown Strategic Planning Initiative, the City is actively focusing in public investment in infrastructure and development of parks, trails and related community facilities. New facilities for Bartlett Park include two new lighted football/soccer fields, water features, an observation deck, fishing docks, hiking trail extensions and renovation of basketball courts, tennis courts, and playground equipment.
