Less than an hour's drive from Baltimore on Maryland's Eastern Shore, a capstone 76-acre acquisition for the Conquest Waterfront Preserve, a 758-acre waterfront park in Queen Anne's County was completed in partnership with the state, county and the Conservation Fund. Situated on a peninsula with 5 miles of shoreline defined by the Chester and Corsica Rivers, the area will preserve important waterfowl habitat and wetland areas. Public access to the bay will offer hiking, bird watching and nature study.
