

- Moved 1990




























New scholarship has improved documentation for Theodate Pope Riddle's role as the principal designer of the main house and connected buildings, as well as other ancillary outbuildings.





Additional Documentation: Landscape and Gardens | South Farm

New scholarship has improved documentation for:

- Theodate's supervisory role in creating the designed landscape, integrating the vistas, fields, and woodland into a unified property
- Landscape features, such as the stone walls, vistas, water features, and sites, as well as "lost" features
- Ancillary buildings on the property, including the historic farmstead








Kalawao, Hawai'i


Expanded Documentation: Events | People | Ideas



Recommendation of Landmarks Committee

The Committee recommends that the National Park System Advisory Board recommend to the Secretary of the Interior the designation of the following properties as National Historic Landmarks, with any additions and corrections as noted by the Committee being made prior to the nominations being forwarded to the Secretary of the Interior for action:

- 1. Grant Cottage, Wilton, New York (Criteria 1 and 2)
- 2. Patsy Cline House, Winchester, Virginia (Criteria 1 and 2)
- 3. Andalusia Farm (Flannery O'Connor Home), Milledgeville, Georgia (Criterion 2)
- 4. Scout's Rest Ranch Headquarters, North Platte, Nebraska (Criteria 1 and 2)
- 5. First Presbyterian Church, Stamford, Connecticut (Criterion 4)
- 6. Pan American Union Headquarters, Washington, DC (Criteria 1 and 4)
- 7. Stabler-Leadbeater Apothecary Shop, Alexandria, Virginia (Criterion 1)
- 8. Western Railroad Stone Arch Bridges and Chester Factory Village Depot, Becket, Middlefield, and Chester, Massachusetts (Criteria 1, 2, and 4; Exception 2)
- 9. Lower Pecos Canyonlands Archeological District, Val Verde County, Texas (Criteria 5 and 6)
- 10. Minong Copper Mining District, Isle Royale National Park, Keweenaw County, Michigan (Criteria 1 and 6)
- 11. West Point Foundry Archeological Site, Cold Spring, New York (Criteria 1 and 6)

The Committee recommends that the National Park System Advisory Board recommend to the Secretary of the Interior the acceptance of the NHL updated documentation for the following National Historic Landmarks, with any additions and corrections as noted by the Committee being made prior to the nominations being forwarded to the Secretary of the Interior for his action:

- 1. Hill-Stead, Farmington, Connecticut (Criteria 1 and 4)
- 2. Kalaupapa Leprosy Settlement, Kalawao, Hawaii (Criteria 1, 2, 3, 4, and 6)

In addition, the Committee recommended the deferral of the property below to allow for continued consultation with interested parties and for a revised nomination to be brought back to the NHL Committee at a future meeting.

1. Rock Island Site II, Rock Island State Park, Door County, Wisconsin (Criterion 6)
