To receive the Cashier card, visit the Illinois Monument.


- Inside the Illinois Monument are the names of every Illinois soldier that fought at Vicksburg. Can you find Albert's Cashier's name? (Hint: He was in the 95 Infantry Company G.



George R. Yost

To receive the Yost card, visit the U. S. S. Cairo Museum *and/or* attend a ranger led talk.

- George Yost proves that anyone can make history. Even though he was only 14 when he served on the Cairo, his diary tells historians more about daily life on the ship than any other document. Have you ever thought about keeping a journal? What would you write about?



Milliken's Bend

To receive the Milliken's Bend card, view the orientation film *or* visit the African American Monument. Then, ask a ranger for the Milliken's Bend brochure.

- Many people believed that black troops couldn't fight, but the battle at Milliken's bend proved them wrong.
- Can you think of a time when people didn't think you could do something? How did that make you feel?



Orion P. Howe

To receive the Howe card, attend a ranger talk at the Stockade Redan, *or* stop at tour stop 5.

- If you're at tour stop 5, get out and walk down Graveyard Road. This is the path that many soldiers, including Howe took when they attacked the Stockade Redan. Walk to the last blue marker and look up at the redan.
- Can you imagine what it was like? All of the gun smoke? Do you think that you could have charged the redan with cannons shooting at you?



The Shirley House

To receive the Shirley House card, visit *and/or* attend a ranger talk at the Shirley House.

- At the top of the steps there is a picture of the Shirley House during the war. Examine it.
- What would it have been like if you were a member of the Shirley family? Would you have liked the soldiers camping in your yard? Or would you want them gone?
