

July brings Lisa Gabrielle Russell to the Weir Farm artist in residency program. Motivated by a desire to comprehend issues of being and existing, Lisa's abstract art work is based on analysis of the interactive nature of light, space, and form. At Weir, she will immerse herself in the landscape, looking for nature

formations: clusters of rock formations, tree/branch configurations, and various plant groupings. She will choose locations that present a variety of color combinations with various degrees of complex layers. She will observe and analyze these motifs, working directly from nature, to extract color and form relationships.

Weir Farm's Artist in Residence program (AIR) selects twelve artists to live and work at Weir Farm each year. To date, more than 158 artists from throughout the U.S., as well as Tunisia, Germany, Australia, India and the Netherlands have participated in the AIR program. Visual artists apply for one month residencies in all media and diverse artistic points of view from traditional to experimental.

The program is co-sponsored by Weir Farm Art Center and Weir Farm National Historic Site and the reception/exhibition is presented by Wilton Library. There is no charge. Registration is suggested.
