Two participants in the massacre; hitherto unpublished portraits painted at Waiilatpu by John Mix Stanley, October 1847. Stanley's note indicates Shu-ma-hici was a son of Tiloukaikt; he was named Edward by Mrs. Whitman after her brother. Stanley often drew Indians with white features.
