IMPORTANT NOTICE TO APPLICANT

This is an application **only** and does not serve as permission to conduct any special activity in the park. The information provided will be used to determine whether a permit will be issued.

Send the completed application via email to whsa_permits@nps.gov. After July 1, 2023, only electronic applications will be accepted as a valid application. A non-refundable application fee is required to process the permit request. Payment for the non-refundable application fee can be made by credit card only. Payment by credit card is done over the phone by calling the park: 575-479-6124 x206 and speaking with the park ranger to process the payment.

Applications will not be processed unless the non-refundable application fee is paid in by credit card as described above.

If your request is approved, a permit containing applicable terms and conditions will be sent you. The permit must be signed by the responsible person and returned to the park for final approval by the Park Superintendent before the permitted activity may begin.

Privacy Act Statement

General: This information is provided pursuant to Public Law 93-579 (Privacy Act of 1974), December 21, 1984, for individuals completing this application.

Authority: The authority to collect information on the attached form is derived from 54 U.S.C. 100101, Promotion and regulation; 54 U.S.C. 100751(a), Regulations; 54 U.S.C. 103104, Recovery of costs associated with special use permits; and 54 U.S.C 100905 Commercial Filming.

Purposes and Uses: The information being collected to allow the park manager to make a value judgment on whether or not to allow the requested use. Information from the application may be transferred to appropriate Federal, State, and local agencies, when relevant to civil, criminal or regulatory investigations or prosecutions.

Effects of Nondisclosure: It is in your best interest to answer all of the questions.
