HISTORY

Brenda Chambers worked as a concessioner employee for Hamilton Stores, located at Fishing Bridge in Yellowstone National Park from 1978 to 1982.

DESCRIPTION

The collection documents Brenda Chamber's time as a concessioner employee for Hamilton Stores in Yellowstone National Park from 1978 to 1982. The collection includes a brief diary describing activities and work assignments. There are also numerous color photographs depicting concessioner employees, activities, and areas around Yellowstone. Also of note are a series of employee rosters for Hamilton Stores employees at Fishing Bridge from 1979 to 1982. Memorabilia includes newsletters, brochures, menus, theater programs, and other ephemera for events in Madison County, Montana, and Jackson Hole and Cody, Wyoming. There are also a few hiking guides. Souvenirs, including a small tray, salt and pepper shakers, a bell, and a petrified specimen have been separated to the museum collection.
