HISTORY

This collection was created by the Yellowstone National Park Archives to house materials which document the Park but have either unknown provenance or a size too small to warrant individual collections. More information about the provenance of individual items is available upon request. This collection may be added to as future donations warrant.

DESCRIPTION

A collection of small manuscripts, photographs, and other ephemera which document the 1988 fires in Yellowstone National Park. The materials are personal images and items, created by employees and local residents. Current materials include small collections by: Dennis Neill, member of the Incident Command Team; Bonnie Hawn; and Richard Powel, NPS Incident Command Team. The images depict the extent and ferocity of the flames, wildland firefighters, fire camps, and aerial fire fighting efforts. There are also images of wildlife and of developed areas within Yellowstone, including the Old Faithful Inn.
