HISTORY

Inda Ernsperger and Cyril Chidwick may have been employees for Shaw & Powell Camping Company and/or at Lake Lodge for the Yellowstone Park Camps Company. Inda Ernsperger and Cyril Chidwick met while employed in Yellowstone, and later married. The images may also include Les and Agnes Spangelo, relatives of the Ernsperger or Chidwick family.

DESCRIPTION

The collection consists of photograph albums and loose photographs of employees in Yellowstone National Park in the 1920s. Images include numerous group shots of employees, employees at work and play, the tent camps, and the features of Yellowstone. There is also one album, mostly dating to about 1919 that appears to be the family homestead. The location is unknown, though it is clearly on the Great Plains.
