Temporary Safety Closures of Roads

Old Coulterville Road and Foresta Road closed within Yosemite National Park due to El Portal Fire

Over 4,000 acres in Yosemite National Park and Stanislaus National Forest were burned by the El Portal Fire. In order to maintain the safety of park visitors, community members, and allow fire management operations to continue unimpeded, the Superintendent of Yosemite National Park has closed the following areas until further notice is given.

By order of the Superintendent of Yosemite National Park and under authority of Title 36, Code of Federal Regulations, Section 1.5(a) and Section (a)(1):

The Old Coulterville Road is closed to motor vehicles from the Flying Spur intersection to the park's boundary with Stanislaus National Forest.

The Foresta Road is closed to motor vehicles at Foresta Falls to the park's boundary with Stanislaus National Forest. It is also closed to motor vehicles in El Portal at the intersection of Granite Street to the park's boundary with Stanislaus National Forest.

Notice of this closure will be posted and the area will be monitored to ensure compliance. Your cooperation in complying with this temporary restriction is greatly appreciated. Please see the attached map for more information.
