Fire Safety Closure

The Lakes Fire was ignited by lightning on approximately June 12, 2016. It is being managed for multiple objectives and, as of August 23, is 189 acres in size. The fire has crossed the trail along Chilnualna Creek and currently presents active fire and fire hazards in the area including:

- Falling limbs, snags (dead standing trees), and fire damaged trees
- Locally smoky conditions which may cause respiratory problems
- Poor visibility due to smoke
- Hot ash and unseen hazards

By order of the Superintendent of Yosemite National Park and under authority of Title 36, Code of Federal Regulations, Section 1.5(a) and Section (a)(1):

The trail segment marked on the accompanying map entitled Lakes Fire Safety Closure dated August 25th, 2016 is closed to all travel.

Notice of closure will be posted and area will be monitored to ensure compliance. Your cooperation in complying with this temporary restriction is greatly appreciated. Please see attached map for more information.

The designation will remain in place until rescinded.


